

August 5, 2020 Meeting Agenda

Meeting called to order at 6:43 pm in lawn area of Pac Shores, Redwood City. Three club officers were in attendance (President, Ricky Najera, was out of state).

Treasurer's update: Jeff Beam reported three members renewed in July. There are presently 66 members. The club is in good financial standing.

Secretary's Correspondence: Membership cards were mailed July 29, 2020. Done thru postal service because handing out at meetings was not possible due to pandemic.

Old Business:

• Club Ride: July 26, 2020 Mario DiSalvo recounted the ride of eleven bikers on Calaveras Road and Niles Canyon in East Bay. It was a nice change from the coast. He recommended that we do it again in the spring when things are greener. New Business:
